## DIRECTIONS

From the South: Take I-75/I-85 North to I-85 North to GA 400 North. Take Exit #2 for Lenox Rd/Buckhead. Exit Right off the ramp, go to the second traffic light and make a right on to Peachtree Rd. InterContinental Buckhead Atlanta is 5 lights down on the Left.

From the North on I-75: Take I-75 to I-285 East to GA 400 South. Take Exit #2 for Lenox Rd/Buckhead. Turn Left off the Exit, then right on Peachtree Rd. The hotel is on the left.
